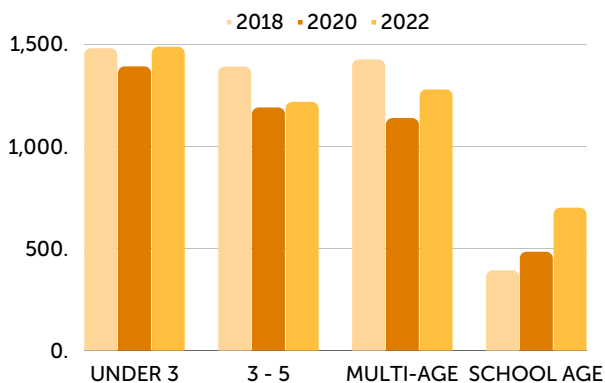
This information only reflects licensed group child care and includes the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative (CCFRI). This data is based on a 30% total response rate.

Fee Changes in the Past 6 Years



**BC introduced its first publicly subsidized fee reduction (called the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative or CCFRI) in 2018 and since then 93% of eligible licensed, full-day programs have been receiving a monthly rebate of up to \$350 per child.*

Monthly Fees, By Age Group
